Mount Huangshan, its Jagged granite peaks, uniquely shaped pine trees, and a sea of clouds create a spectacular landscape of great interest to artists and photographers.






240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China








China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

1	Day 1 Huangshan	 airport-hotel transfer in Huangshan
2	Day 2 Huangshan	 breakfast, lunch  Tangyue Archways , Bao's Family Garden, Chengkan Village The Tangyue Archways are the biggest archway complex in Anhui Province. It is a famous representative of archway architecture of Ming and Qing Dynasty . The Bao's Family Garden is the largest private garden in China. There you could enjoy all kinds of fancy bonsai. Chengkan Village, the mysterious Eight Diagrams village, is a perfect place to see distinctive Ming Dynasty architecture. Good to know: since you'll carry your own bag up Mt. Huangshan tomorrow unless you hire a porter, it is suggested that you leave your big luggage in the hotel in Huangshan City and bring only a small handbag or backpack with you.
3	Day 3 Huangshan	 breakfast, lunch, dinner  Mount Huangshan Listed as a World Cultural and Natural Heritage Site, Mount Huangshan enjoys a reputation as "the Number One Mountain under Heaven", most notably for its strangely-shaped pines, unusual stones, cloud sea, and hot springs.

4	Day 4 Huangshan	 breakfast, lunch, dinner  Today, enjoy a full-day exploration and photography of Mt. Huangshan, including Cloud-dispelling Pavilion, Purple Cloud Peak , and the Xihai Grand Canyon (also called West Sea Grand Canyon), which has relatively fewer travelers than the main trails and offers breathtaking scenery. Stay overnight at hotel in the top of the mountain.
5	Day 5 Huangshan	 breakfast, lunch  Today, rise early and wait for the sunrise on Mount Huangshan . Weather permitting, you will view a breathtaking sight this morning. The mountain peaks rise above the clouds, and the sunlight illuminates a ever-changing sea of clouds below. You can see this spectacle from a lookout with a short distance from your hotel. Admire the Lion Peak and Beginning-to-believe Peak before taking the Yungu cable car down the mountain. Continue to visit the hot spring scenic area for more views. If you are interested, you could take a hot spring bath to relax the body (at your own expense). Afterwards, take a car ride back to Huangshan city.
6	Day 6 Huangshan	 airport transfer in Huangshan  breakfast, lunch  Hongcun Ancient Village, Xidi Ancient Village Hongcun Ancient Village (UNESCO) is well-known as a beautiful village looks like “ink-painting”. It was also the shooting scene for the Oskar-awarded movie “Crouching Tiger Hidden Dragon”. Xidi Ancient Village (UNESCO) is a boat-shaped village, boasted as “a Living Ancient Residential Museum in China” . Service ends.
