240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China






China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

1	Day 1 Shanghai - Huangshan (by bullet train)	 hotel - train station transfer in Shanghai, train station - hotel transfer in Huangshan
2	Day 2 Huangshan	 breakfast, lunch  Mount Huangshan Listed as a World Cultural and Natural Heritage Site, Mount Huangshan enjoys a reputation as “the Number One Mountain under Heaven”, most notably for its strangely-shaped pines, unusual stones, cloud sea, and hot springs.
3	Day 3 Huangshan - Wuyishan (by bullet train)	 train station transfer in Huangshan, train station-hotel transfer in Wuyishan  breakfast, lunch  Hongcun Ancient Village, Tunxi Old Street Hongcun Ancient Village (UNESCO) is well-known as a beautiful village looks like “ink-painting”. It was also the shooting scene for the Oskar-awarded movie “Crouching Tiger Hidden Dragon”. Tunxi Old Street has many featured shops and good restaurants, and makes it one of the favorite tourist spots. It is also one of the best-preserved sections of Huangshan City.

4	Day 4 Wuyishan	 breakfast, lunch  Wuyi Mountain Enjoy a full-day excursion to the Wuyi Mountain. Located in northwest Fujian Province, the Wuyi Mountain is known as the "most wonderful mountain in southeast China", and was listed as World Cultural and Natural Heritage in 1999. It is one of the most famous Danxia Landforms in China. You will visit the Cloud Cave, Jiesun Peak, Tea Cave, and take a bamboo raft along the Nine-bend Stream.
5	Day 5 Wuyishan - Shanghai (by bullet train)	 train station transfer in Wuyishan  breakfast, lunch  Today, continue to explore the Wuyi Mountains Scenic Area. Take a visit to the Harmonious Temple, Water Curtain Cave, and Eagle Mouth Rock. Then, learn about the history of the oolong tea at the Dahongpao Oolong Tea Plantation, the best Oolong tea plantation in the world. Later, transfer to the train station in Wuyishan city and take a bullet train to Shanghai. Service ends.
